Love

Community

We are a community that meets at Emmanuel Christian Centre (Romans 16:5), being salt and light to the community around us (Matthew 5:13-16). As the Church we aim to be a family (Hebrews 2:11 & 1 Timothy 5:1-2) which grows together as the body of Christ (1 Cor. 12:27) and brings Jesus' message to our town (Matthew 10:27).

Honour

We seek to show honour in every aspect of our lives. This means to honour God above all (Revelation 5:13), to honour authority (Romans 13:1 & 1 Peter 2:17), to honour our leaders (1 Timothy 5:17), to honour each other (Romans 12:10), to honour financially (Proverbs 3:9), and to become vessels of honour (2 Timothy 2:20-21).
