

Group Video Guide : My Sheep Hear My Voice (2021) by Joseph C. Hedgecock

Introduction

- Read a definition of G2842 in the Greek. Does that excite you?
- Consider areas of your life where you knew something was going to be wrong and you knew something shouldn't work out or shouldn't be done a certain way.
- Consider any area of your life when you know what God has said but maybe have been deceived and you are now questioning, "did God really say that?" (like Eve in the Garden of Eden)
- Is there any time in your life when you went against the will of God? i.e. You knew God told you to do something, but you decided to go against it anyway.
- What were the consequences? Consider these consequences personally & recognise that we need to take ownership of these decisions and not blame others.
- Did you do something good, but it didn't work out quite how you expected because it wasn't the good that comes from God but the good that came from your own understanding? Discuss these.
- Consider what it means to have more fun with God when things are going wrong than most people do when things are going right. Have you ever experienced that?
- Have you got some examples of when you didn't have joy and things got worse because of your attitude? Share with one another the times where you have experienced this.
- Ask God to soften your heart so that you can release your faith into Him, and He can be your first love. (Ezekiel 36:26-27)
- Discuss what it means that the motivation for hearing God's voice has to be 'love'.
